- ▶ South Yorkshire's Community Foundation (SYCF) supports community groups throughout the region with grant funding and advice, helping people facing hardship and disadvantage, and those working to improve the communities they live in.



- ▶ We manage over £12m of endowments and trust funds, together with funds from central and local government, as well as many other public sector bodies.
- ▶ We are the largest grant giving charity in South Yorkshire, with over 38 years experience in community support, and we are a member of the 47 strong UKCF Network of community foundations.

Grants in South Yorkshire

- SYCF run two rounds of our Community Grants every year. The next round opens in June.
- Donor investment enables us to make c£250,000 available every year for community and charitable groups based across South Yorkshire with a turnover of less than £200k.
- Grants of up to £5,000 for projects, capital or core costs
- Priority will be given to groups whose remit fits identified areas of focus; for 2024 that is Education and learning, Poverty deprivation, Work and the local economy, Health & well-being, including physical and mental health, Homelessness, Social isolation and Supporting people with disabilities
- Alongside this we run a Small Grants programme on a rolling basis each year, specifically aimed at newly constituted groups with a turnover of less than £10,000. Grants of up to £1,000 are available.

Grants in Sheffield

- ▶ SYCF are currently running two programmes on behalf of the South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority and Sheffield City Council from the Shared Prosperity Fund: the Low Carbon Community and Cultural and SEGA (Social Enterprise Growth Accelerator programmes).
- ▶ Up to £15,000 is available to community and cultural public facing buildings to make capital interventions to reduce carbon emissions and increase efficiency. An initial Expression of Interest to SYCF alongside confirmation of building ownership/tenancy and 3 months of utility bills will enable a Premises Diagnostic and if appropriate, an in-person Energy Audit by specialists to identify energy saving work.
- ▶ Up to £1,000 is also available to social enterprises of any size based in Sheffield for work that can take your business to the next level. Grants could pay for digital interventions, marketing, equipment and some staffing costs. The SEGA programme also includes yearlong membership to the Sheffield Chamber of Commerce and access to a business mentor and inclusion in the Sheffield Social Enterprise Network to boost your business. Register with the programme first, then a standard Grant Application Form can be completed.
- ▶ Projects must complete/money spent by December 2024.

Grants in Barnsley, Doncaster & Rotherham

SYCF run a number of grant programmes from local Wind Farms which are open on a rolling basis for groups based within a 3-mile radius of each location.

- ▶ **Park Springs in Barnsley** intended to improve the physical, built or social environment of the local area in Great Houghton Little Houghton, Grimethorpe, Darfield, Billingley and parts of Cudworth. Up to £10,000 available.
- ▶ **Loscar in Rotherham** to support environmental sustainability and general community activities to groups based in Harthill, Woodall, Thorpe Salvin and Wales. Up to £5,000 available.
- ▶ **Tween Bridge in Doncaster** supporting local community projects in Thorne and Moorends, parts of Hatfield, Hatfield Woodhouse, Fosterhouses, Stainforth, Ealand, Fishlake, Crowle and Sandtoft. Up to £7,500 is available and multi year projects will be considered.


